American Institute of Architects Continue Education System (AIA/CES): Acuity Brands Lighting is a registered provider with the AIA/CES. Administered through the Jim H. McClung Lighting Center, Hydrel offers programs which qualify for one hour of credit in the category of Health, Safety and Welfare.

American Society of Landscape Architects Continuing Professional Education (ASLA/CPE): Hydrel is a registered provider with the ASLA/CPE, and offers programs which qualify for one hour of credit

Most states accept AIA/CES accredited programs to recertify other professions, including interior design and professional engineering. Refer to guidelines set by your state board. ASLA/CPE education programs may qualify toward state continuing education licensing requirements in landscape architecture where mandated. Hydrel programs also qualify as learning units (LU) for Lighting Certified (LC) recertification. Note that no more than 1/3 of your total LU hours should come from manufacturer supplied programs.
